Author Visit Coming On April 7, 8 and 9th



Eric Rohmann

Mr. Rohmann will be visiting Monroe Elementary the 2nd week of April. Eric Rohmann is an award-winning author and illustrator. He was born in Riverside, Illinois and grew up in Downers Grove, Illinois. He currently lives in a suburb of Chicago. Eric holds degrees in fine arts from Arizona State University and Illinois State University. In addition to writing and illustrating children's books, he has taught printmaking, painting and fine bookmaking. He is also a former teacher and has worked in a zoo.

Eric Rohmann has written and illustrated several books for young readers. He says, "I usually start with a picture, then the words and story line follow. I was a visual artist first, so this seems natural." Eric drew a picture of a rabbit with an airplane and asked himself, "What would a rabbit do with an airplane." This is how the book *My Friend Rabbit* began. *My Friend Rabbit* won the Caldecott medal in 2003. The Caldecott medal is the highest honor an illustrated book can receive. His new book, *A Kitten Tale* was released in January 2008 and has already received four starred reviews. Eric Rohmann has also created book jackets for a number of novels and has illustrated *King Crow* by Jennifer Armstrong and *The Prairie Train* by Antoine O'Flatharta.



A limited number of his books will be available for purchase in the elementary media center. Eric Rohmann will autograph after his presentations.
